Fields:

- •Report Date Range Listed at the top right corner of each report is the reporting date range for the report. All gifts and pledges listed on the report were processed between the listed dates.
- •Class Year Under this header is the list of all classmates who graduated in this class year and made a gift during the report range.
- •Name and Primary Contact Information Lists the name and address of each donor. The current mailing address is listed below their name. The donors' preferred phone and email address are listed in the next column, when available. If you hover over the email address you can click on it to open your email program to send a thank you email to the donor directly.
- •Gift Date The date the gift was received and/or processed by the College.
- •Type This column describes the form of the gift: Cash (a gift made via check or credit card), Pay-cash (payment made towards a pledge balance), Match (a gift made by a donor's employer that "matches" all or part of the gift and is credited to the class, Bequest (a type of planned gift), Stock/Property, Pledge (a promised gift to the College), Recurring Gift-Pay Cash (a gift that is spread out over time with payments made each month)
- •Fund The area of the College the classmate is supporting with her contribution, (e.g. the Simmons Fund, the General Undergraduate Scholarship Fund)
